

## **Sigma Phi Alpha Hu-Friedy Scholarship**

The Sigma Phi Alpha Hu-Friedy scholarship was established at the Sigma Phi Alpha Annual Session in March 1998 in Minneapolis, Minnesota. The purpose of the scholarship is to award a Sigma Phi Alpha component chapter \$500.00 towards the purchase of Hu-Friedy hand held instruments, ultrasonic inserts, cassettes, and other associated products. **This scholarship is sponsored by Hu-Friedy and will be awarded at the 2018, Sigma Phi Alpha Annual Session in Orlando, Florida.**

### **SELECTION PROCESS**

1. Applicants must be voting members (faculty, charter, or alumni) of an active component chapter.
2. Applicants must have had at least 2 years continuous active status.
3. The Component Chapter must be an active chapter.
4. The Component Chapter must be organized within an active dental hygiene program which is accredited by a national agency recognized by the Society.
5. The Component Chapter bylaws cannot be in conflict with those of the Society. All Component Chapters will be required to submit a current copy of their component chapter bylaws.
6. Submit a brief essay that demonstrates (on application form) how the component chapter (member or members) have contributed to the field of dental hygiene in the areas of scholarship, leadership, and service.
7. Complete the general information application form.

### **SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE:**

A committee consisting of SPA members and Hu-Friedy representatives will evaluate all applications and select the recipient.

All applications are due not later than **February 1, 2018.**
